Public and Private Transportation



Words to Know

destination: place to which a person is going fare: money a person pays to ride in a bus, taxi, train, or airplane route: a fixed way to go

schedule: a written or printed list of fixed times for departures and arrivals

Have you ever used a train, bus, subway, taxi, or airplane to get from one place to another? If you have, you have used public transportation. *Public transportation* is any transportation that can be used by all people.

Private transportation is any means of travel that you own. You are using private transportation when you use your own car, bicycle, roller skates, or even shoes that you wear to walk from one place to another.

There are many reasons people use public transportation. Some people take a bus or subway because they don't like to drive in heavy traffic. Other people don't drive because parking spaces are often hard to find. Many people who live in big cities don't own cars. They must take public transportation to places they want to travel.
