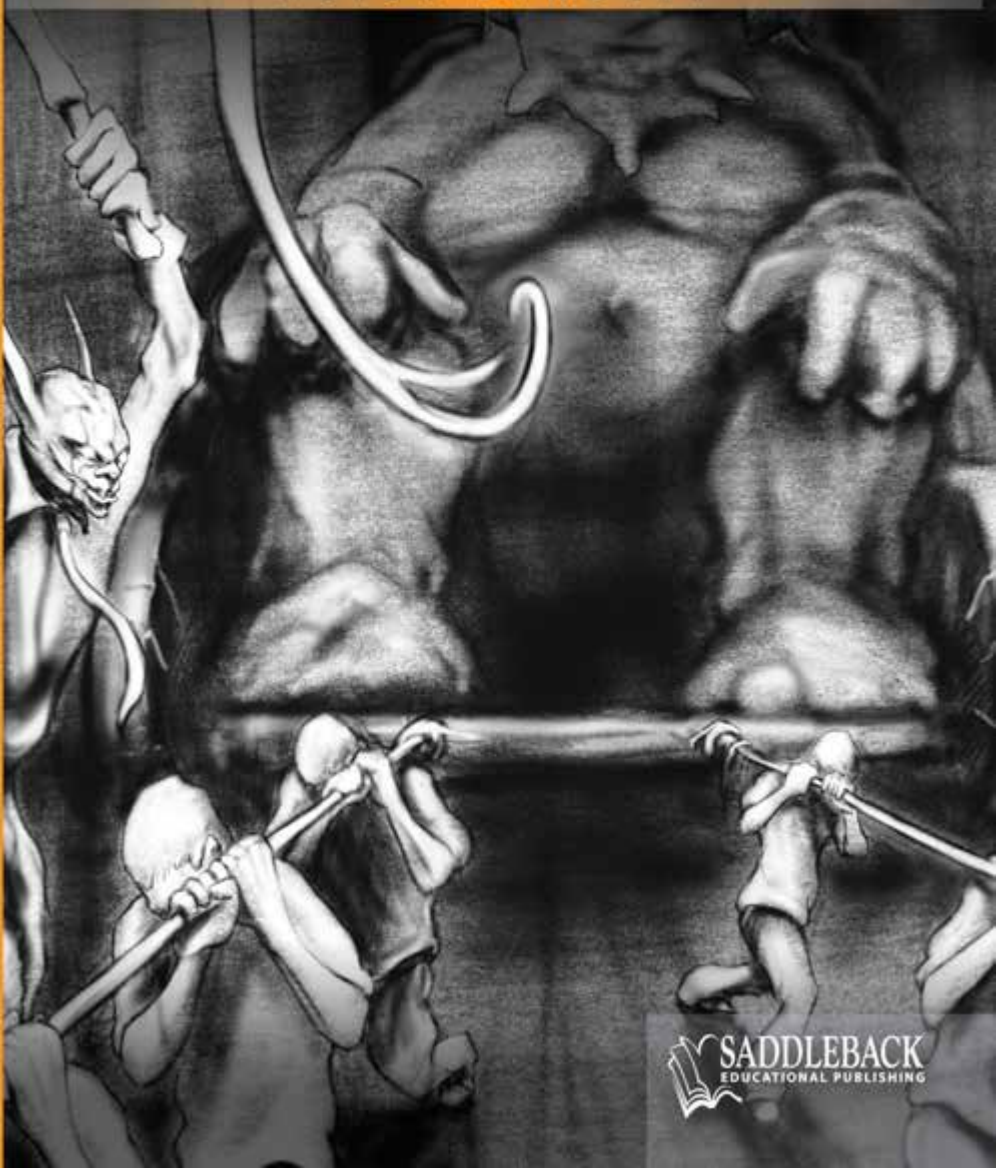

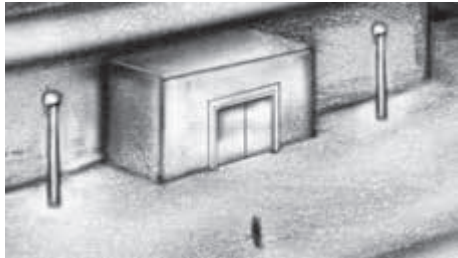

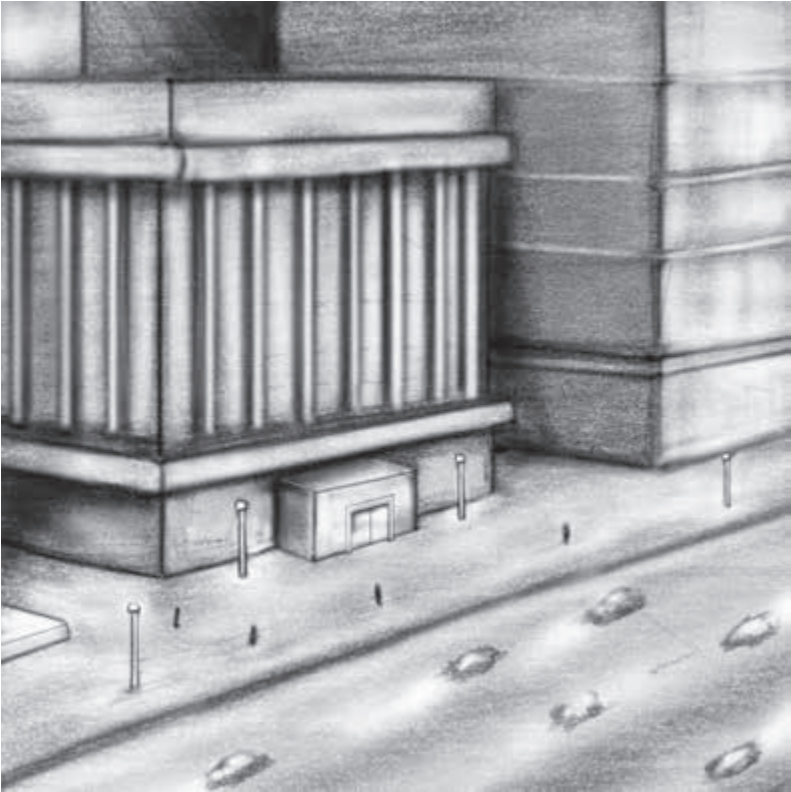

Chapter One: The Old Man's Home

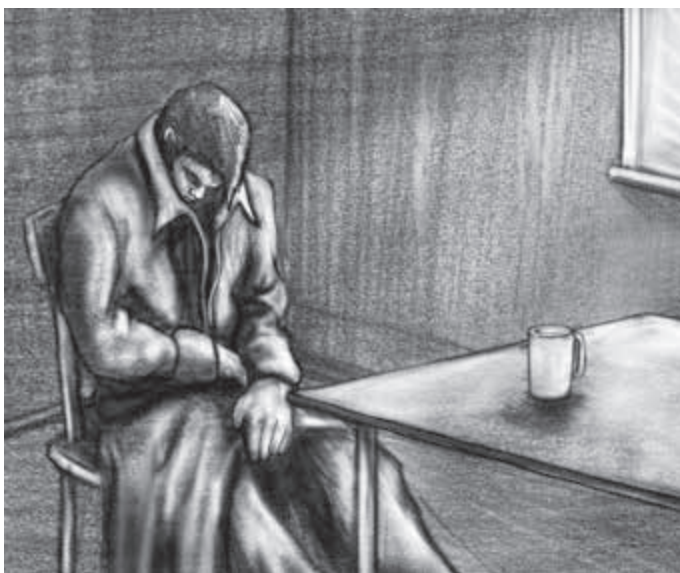
The Dark Man is in the good part of the city.



He is at the home of the Old Man.



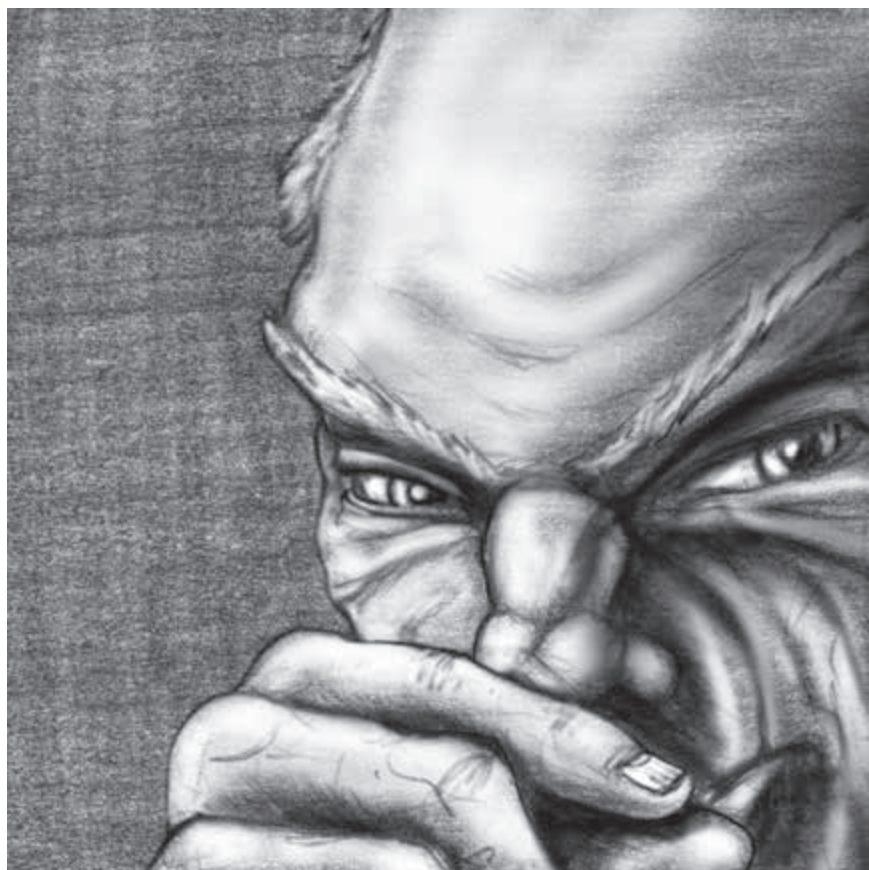
The Dark Man is weary and sits back in a chair.
