


Vowel Combinations “ai” and “ay”

When two vowels are together, usually the first vowel is **long** and the second vowel is **silent**. Remember: The long vowel sound makes the sound of the letter’s name!

The “a” makes the long vowel sound and the “i” or “y” beside it is silent.
