Rules: The past tense is used to tell about something that already happened.

The regular past tense is formed by adding ed to the end of the verb.

Example: walk walked

Irregular verbs are verbs that do not add ed to the end of the verb to make the past

tense.

Here are some ways that irregular verbs form the irregular past tense.

Sometimes the vowel and some consonants are changed.

Example: buy bought

Sometimes the word stays the same.

Example: cut cut

Sometimes the entire word changes.

Example: go went

Rule: Some irregular verbs form the past tense by changing the vowel to o.

Here are some examples.
