Ask me where these people are. Where are these people?

Ask me which one is the cashier. Which one is the cashier?

Ask me how I know the women is buying groceries. *How do you know the woman is buying groceries?*

Ask me what the boy is holding. What is the boy holding?

Ask me what could be in the woman's shopping cart. What could be in the woman's shopping cart?

Change this sentence into a question. Some foods cost more than other foods. *Do some foods cost more than other foods?*



Regular/Irregular Past Tense: Card 2

Kortney baked a pie for a contest. What did Kortney bake? *She baked a pie.*

Her pie won the first prize. What did her pie win? *Her pie won the first prize.*

The judges gave her a blue ribbon. What did they give her? *They gave her a blue ribbon.*

After the contest, she cut a piece of pie for herself. When did she cut a piece of pie for herself? *She cut a piece for herself after the contest.*

She ate the whole piece. What did she eat? She ate the whole piece.


Fix this sentence. Last year Kortney winned second prize. *Last year Kortney won second prize*.



Pronouns, Possessive Nouns: Card 7

Lisa hangs up her scarf. Whose scarf is it? It is Lisa's/her scarf. Whose skates are these? These / They are Lisa's / her skates. What matches Lisa's scarf? Lisa's/Her hat matches her scarf. Where are Lisa's mittens? Her mittens / They are on her hands. What will Lisa unzip? She will unzip her coat.

Fix this sentence. Them skates look new. *Those skates / They look new.*



Which snowball is the smallest? This one (right) is the smallest.

Which snowball is the largest? This one (left) is the largest.

Which hat is medium sized? This hat (center) is medium sized.

Who is smaller than the girl (center)? *This one (right) is smaller than the girl.*

Who is taller than the girl? *He* (*left*) is taller than the girl.

Fix this sentence. Randy has the most biggest snowball. *Randy has the biggest snowball.*
