

A Frog in the Tree

Picture 1: Molly is **licking** an ice cream cone. It tastes **delicious!** Look!
A **frog** is **sitting** up in the **tree**. Gribbit!

Picture 2: Molly sits **next** to the tree. She is still licking her ice cream cone.
Look! The frog is **hopping in** the tree.

Picture 3: Molly stops licking her ice cream cone. Look! The frog is **jumping out** of the tree.

Picture 4: Oh, no! The frog is jumping into the ice cream cone! He is hungry, too!
Ahhhhh! Molly is surprised!

Suggested Props

ice cream cone — a piece of yellow construction paper wrapped into a cone shape

ice cream — a piece of construction paper crumpled into a ball shape and placed into the cone

tree — a student standing on a chair with her arms stretched out

toy frog — Have the student who is pretending to be a tree hold the toy frog in one of her hands. When it is time for the frog to hop in the tree, she can toss the toy frog from one hand to the other. When it is time for the frog to jump out of the tree, she can drop the frog into the paper ice cream cone.
