

- Goal** to learn vocabulary related to shapes and colors
- Players** 2-4 players or teams
- Overview** Players try to be the first to color their individual game shapes by answering questions or following directions related to shapes and colors.
- Materials**
- **Kaleidoscope Game Cards** (page 74)
 - **Kaleidoscope** game board (page 75)
 - different-colored crayons for each player or team

Game Play

- Photocopy the game board and the **Game Cards**. Cut apart the cards, shuffle them, and put them facedown on the table beside the game board.
- Give each player or team several crayons of different colors, and assign each player (team) a shape to color on the game board. Play then proceeds as follows:
 - ▲ The first player (team) draws a card, reads it, and answers the question or follows the direction.
 - ▲ If the player's response is correct, she colors one of her designated shapes on the game board, places the card in a discard pile, and her turn is over.
 - ▲ If the player's response is incorrect, she places the card on the bottom of the pile and her turn is over.
- The first player (team) to color all of her shapes in the Kaleidoscope wins.

Optional Play

- Instead of using the cards provided, have the players take turns describing the shapes and colors of things around them.
