

Activity 1 (loud, quiet)

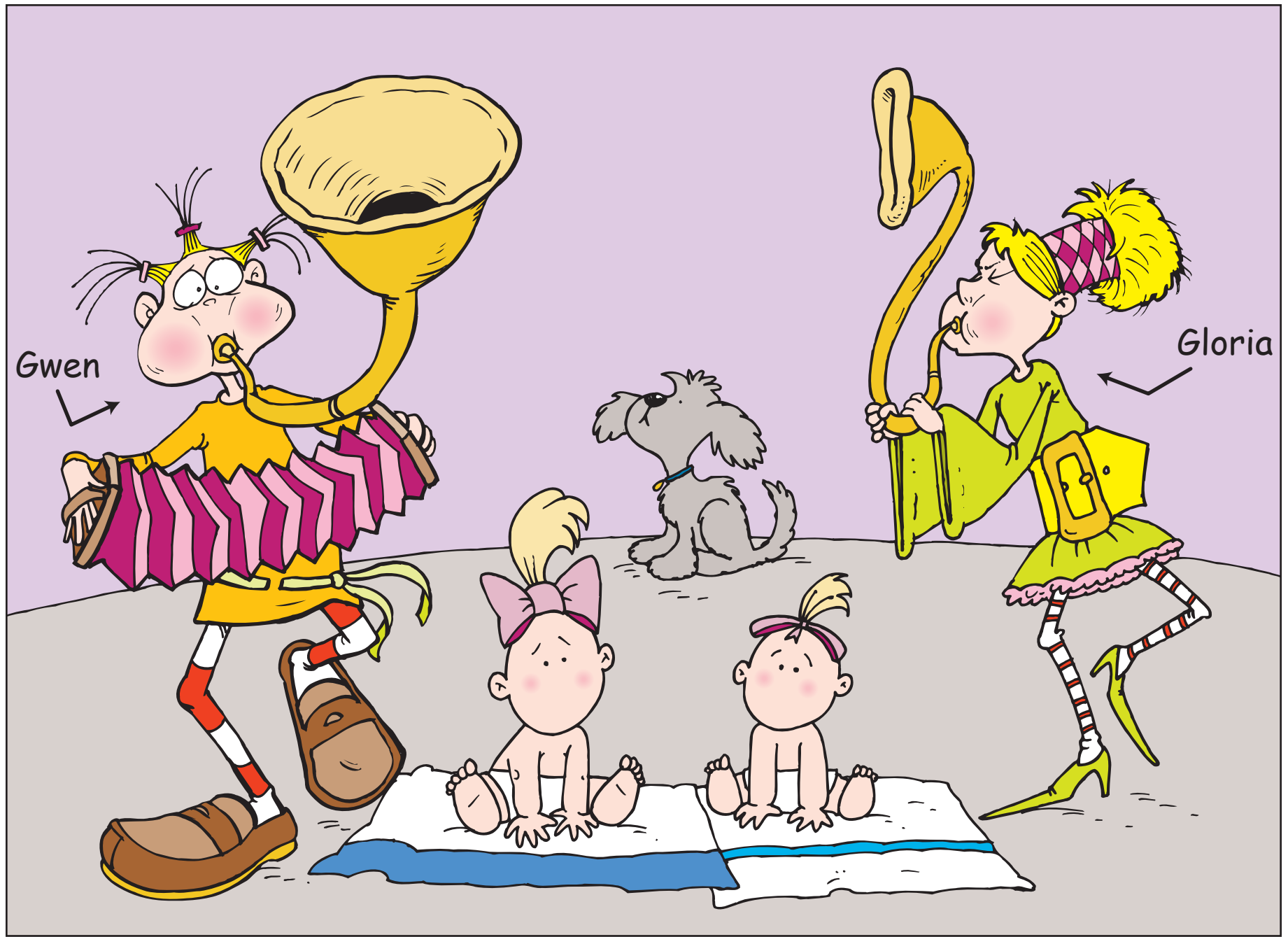
Gwen and Gloria Gilbert are babysitting two baby girls. They are trying to entertain the babies by playing their instruments. Let's see if their **loud** music makes the babies happy.

1. Gwen plays the accordion. It is **loud**. Draw big, blue musical notes around the accordion to show it is **loud**.
2. One baby is crying. She is **loud**. Use your black marker to draw an open mouth on one of the babies. Then write "Waaa" above her head.
3. The other baby is **quiet**. Draw a sad frown on the **quiet** baby.
4. Gloria's horn is a **quiet** horn. Draw tiny, green musical notes coming out of her horn to show it is **quiet**.
5. The dog is **quiet**, too. Use your black marker to open his mouth. Write "Woof" above his head. Now the dog is **loud**.
6. Gwen's horn is very **loud**. It is so **loud**, it hurts everyone's ears. Draw red ear plugs in everyone's ears.

Activity 2 (wide, narrow)

The Gilbert sisters have many things that are **wide** and **narrow**. Let's find some of them.

1. Look at the two horns. One has a **narrow** opening. Color this horn green.
2. The other horn has a **wide** opening. Color that horn red.
3. Gwen and Gloria are both wearing belts. Color the **wide** belt black. Color the **narrow** belt red.
4. Gwen and Gloria are both wearing striped stockings. Add green to the stockings that have **wide** stripes. Add blue to the stockings that have **narrow** stripes.
5. Use your black marker to give the baby who has a **wide** ribbon in her hair a mouth that is **wide** open. Give the baby who has the **narrow** ribbon in her hair a **narrow** smile.
6. Draw a blue circle around the **wide** shoes.
7. One Gilbert sister is wearing a dress with **wide** sleeves. Draw a black star on each of her sleeves.
8. One of the blankets has a **narrow**, blue stripe on it. Color the rest of this blanket green.

13 The Exotic Animal Circus

Activity 1 (tall, taller, tallest)

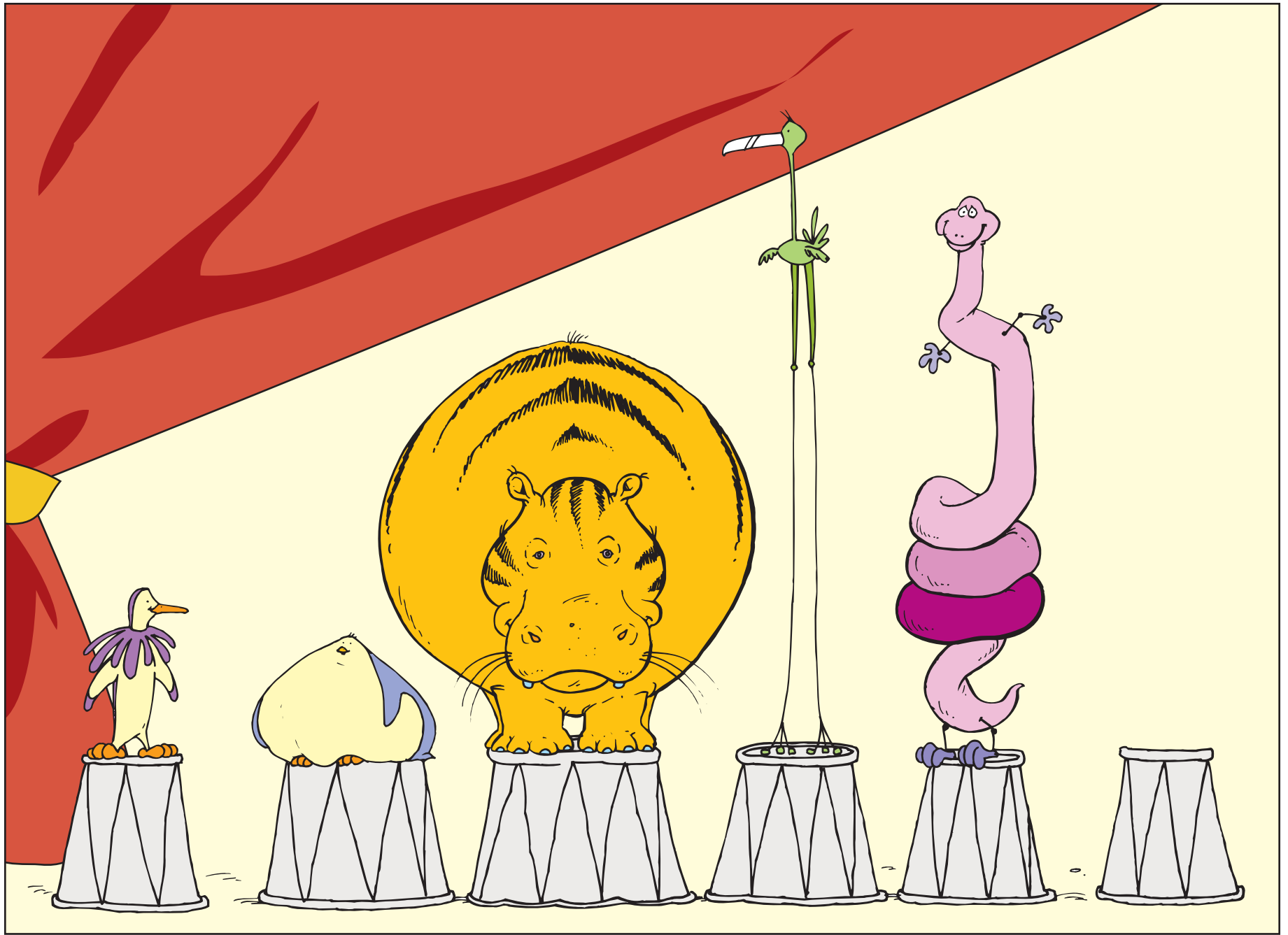
The Exotic Animal Circus has many fascinating animals.

1. Find the two penguins. Which one is **taller**? Color its stand red and green.
2. Find the **tallest** animal. Color its stand blue and black.
3. Find the animal that is **taller** than the penguins, but not as **tall** as the snake. Color its stand red and blue.
4. Find the animal that is **taller** than all the other animals, except one. Color its stand black and green.
5. Draw a **tall** black hat on the snake to make it **taller** than the bird.
6. Draw your own animal on the empty stand. If your animal is the **tallest** animal, color its stand red and black. If it is not the **tallest** animal, color its stand green and blue.
7. Draw stars above the heads of all the animals that are **taller** than the animal you drew.
8. Draw stars below the stands of all the animals that are not as **tall** as the animal you drew.

Activity 2 (heavy, heavier, heaviest)

The Exotic Animal Circus has animals of all shapes and sizes.

1. Do you think the green bird looks **heavy**? If you do, color its beak blue. If you don't, color its beak red.
2. Find the animal that looks the **heaviest**. Draw a black beard on its chin.
3. Look at the two penguins. Draw long, red hair on the penguin that is **heavier**.
4. Find the two tallest animals. Which one looks **heavier**? Draw two horns on its head.
5. Find the animal that looks **heavier** than all the other animals, except one. Put some black spots on its body.
6. Draw your own animal on the empty stand. If your animal is the **heaviest** animal, color its stand red. If it is not the **heaviest** animal, color its stand blue.
7. Draw stars above the heads of all the animals that look **heavier** than the animal you drew.
8. Draw stars below the stands of all the animals that do not look as **heavy** as the animal you drew.
