Overview Players try to earn points by collecting sheep and correctly predicting

what should happen next in various situations.

Materials • Counting Sheep Game Items (pages 84-85)

• Counting Sheep game board (page 86)

colored pencil for each player

die

Game Play

- Photocopy the game board and place it within reach of all players. Give each player a colored pencil.
- Set a time limit for the game or predetermine how many turns each player will have.
- Game play proceeds as follows:
 - Select a question at random from the **Game Items** sheet and read the question and the multiple-choice answers to the first player.
 - If the player does not answer the question correctly, his turn is over and play passes to the next player.
 - If the player answers the question correctly, he rolls the die. He then writes his initials on a sheep that has a number equal to his roll and his turn is over.
 - If the player rolls a number and there are no more sheep with that number left on the board, he cannot claim a sheep and his turn is over.
- At the end of the game, players add up the numbers on the sheep they have claimed. The player with the highest total is the winner.

Optional Play

■ If you want to increase the difficulty level, have players make their own predictions instead of providing them with the multiple-choice answers.
