"It was okay," Lena says.

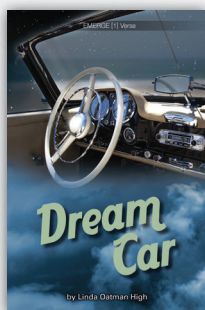
