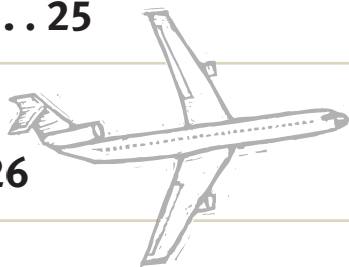

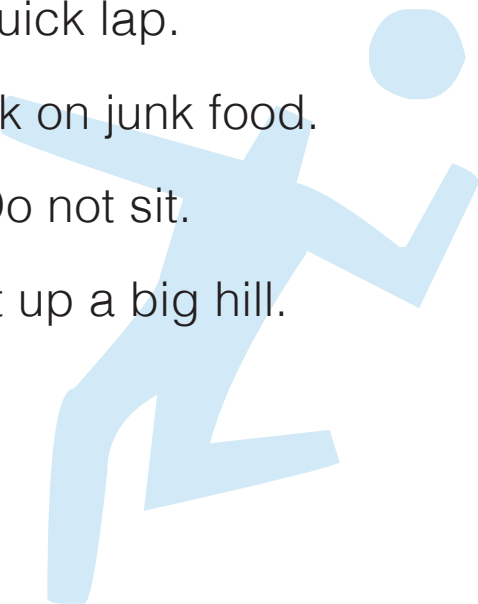


# GET FIT

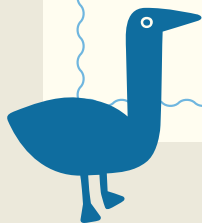
