



Following Directions / Answering Questions

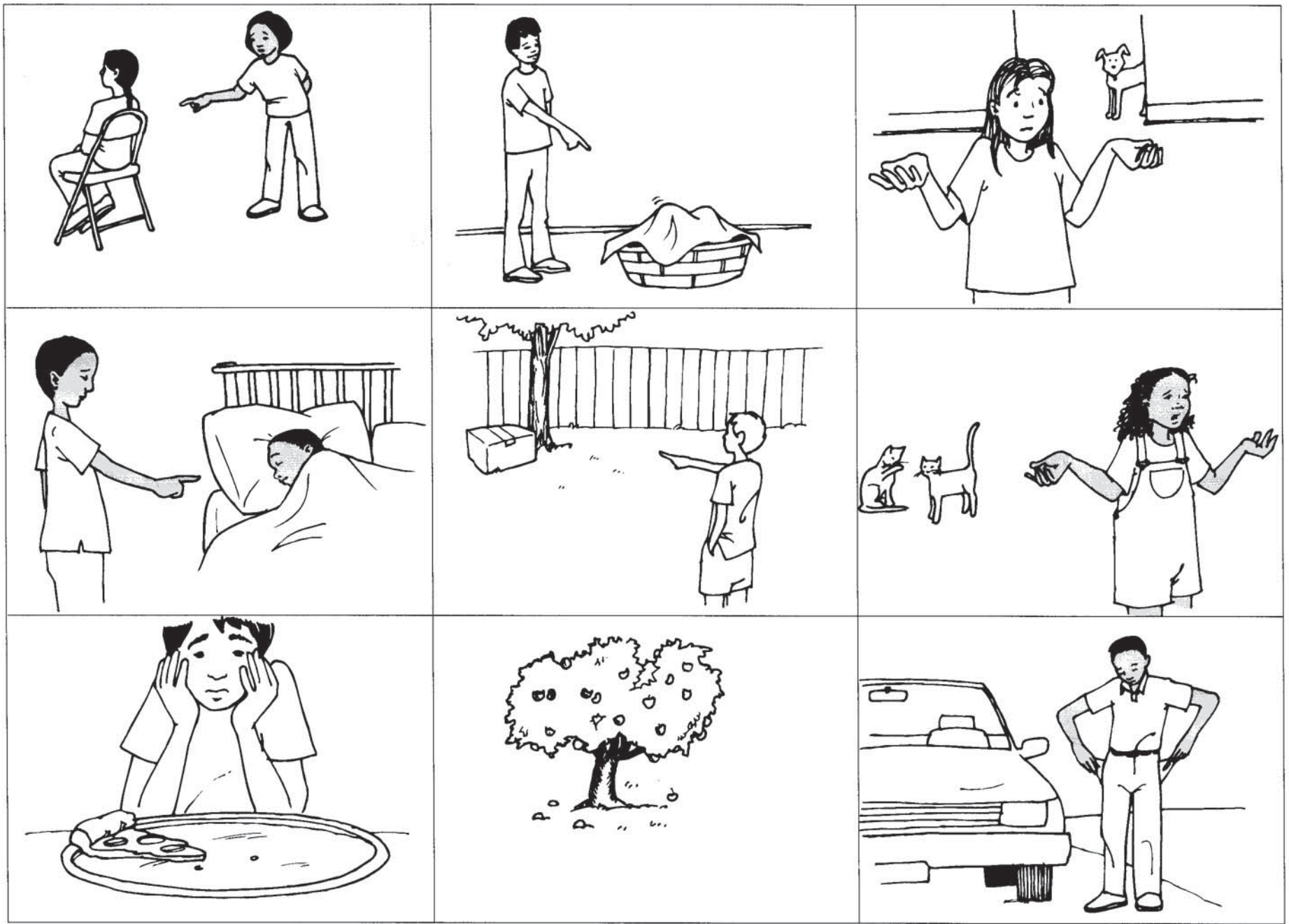
Say, "Look at these pictures. Listen to these sentences."

2. Put a check mark on the box Tito locked. What did Tito do? (Tito locked the box.)
3. Draw a star on the girl who pulled her own tooth. What did she do? (She pulled her tooth.)
4. Make an X on the refrigerator door that Marie closed. What did Marie do after she got the milk from the refrigerator? (She closed the door.)
5. Circle the thing Mary Lou dropped on the floor. What did Mary Lou drop? (She dropped her ice cream.)
6. Underline the zipper that Mario zipped. What did Mario do? (Mario zipped his jacket.)
7. Draw a box around the hot chocolate that Sasha poured. What did Sasha pour? (She poured hot chocolate.)
8. Put an X on the door that Ty opened. What did Ty open? (He opened the door.)
9. Circle the boy who looked out the window. What did he do? (He looked out the window.)

Auditory Bombardment

Say, "Ask these questions after me." Then point to the appropriate picture and say:

1. Tasha asked, "Who is sitting in my chair?" What did Tasha ask? (Who is sitting in my chair?)

2. "What is in the basket?" Hon asked. What did Hon ask? (What is in the basket?)
3. Sarah lost her dog. She said, "Where is my dog?" Tell me what Sarah asked. (Where is my dog?)
4. Jerome looked at his bed and asked, "Who is sleeping in my bed?" What did Jerome ask? (Who is sleeping in my bed?)
5. Something strange was by the tree. Ben asked, "What is by the tree?" What did Ben ask? (What is by the tree?)
6. Melvina can't find her cats. She looked around and asked, "Where are my cats?" Tell me what Melvina asked. (Where are my cats?)
7. Someone ate Tony's pizza. He said, "Who ate my pizza?" What did Tony say? (Who ate my pizza?)
8. Harry saw an apple tree and asked, "What grows on that tree?" What did Harry ask? (What grows on that tree?)
9. Mr. Jones lost his car keys. He said, "Where are my car keys?" What did he ask? (Where are my car keys?)

Following Directions / Answering Questions

Say to the student:

1. Did he buy some groceries? Circle his sack. What did I ask? (Did he buy some groceries?)
2. Does she have a purse? Underline her purse. What did I ask? (Does she have a purse?)
3. Do the bananas have stickers? Put a star on the bananas. What did I ask? (Do the bananas have stickers?)
4. Did an egg break? Put an X on the egg carton. What did I ask? (Did an egg break?)
5. Does the cashier have a cash register? Draw a box around it. What did I ask? (Does the cashier have a cash register?)
6. Do the cans have labels? Put a check mark on a can. What did I ask? (Do the cans have labels?)
7. Did he buy cereal? Put an X on a cereal box. What did I ask? (Did he buy cereal?)
8. Does the door say "Out"? Circle the word "Out." What did I ask? (Does the door say "Out"?)
9. Do the shelves look full? Draw a big star on one of the shelves. What did I ask? (Do the shelves look full?)
